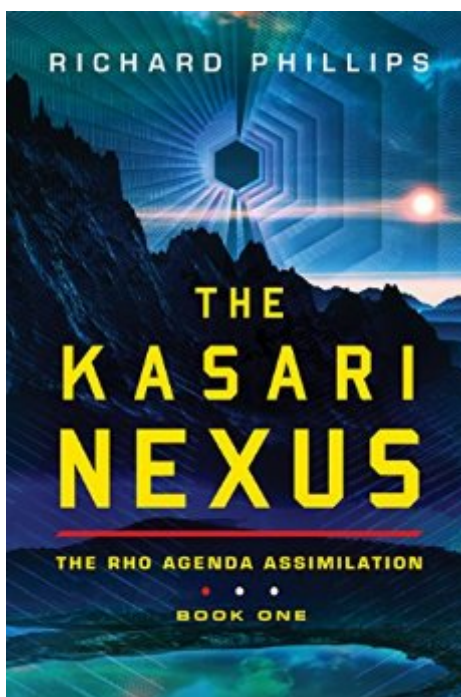


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The Kasari Nexus (Rho Agenda Assimilation Book 1)

The entire Rho Agenda Series is superb. Do read the books in order, as the narrative is a fine tapestry and character development complex. The story has many surprises and they start off at the very beginning. I have always liked the multiple story lines and multiple perspectives, because it's nice to wonder "what will happen to Character A next?!?" while thoroughly enjoying Character Bs story.It was good enough to make me want to reread the previous Rho novels (I am finished with 4 of the 6). This novel is as much science as it is fiction, and it will draw you into the lives of the main characters to the point where you can feel their emotions. The book begins with a character list and a brief setting of the series of events taking place at the time this book begins.In the effort to close the wormhole gateway that would allow the Kasari to begin their invasion of earth an explosion kills the evil Dr. Stephenson. The resulting events trap Jennifer and Raul in the alien ship and send them into the wormhole headed for God knows where.The United States under the leadership of President Ted Benton has now agreed to join an international alliance known as the United Federation of Nation States, ceding US federal authority to the UFNS. Their dream of building the Stephenson Center for Inter-Species Reconciliation will finally be a reality and a new gateway will be constructed.Jack Gregory, Senator Hagerman and a handful of people who have been given special powers by the Altreian ship that crashed to earth after a battle with the Kasari are tasked with trying to stop the UFNS from rebuilding the gateway.If you haven't read the previous six books, The Rho Agenda and The Rho Agenda Inception series, you will enjoy this book as a

stand-alone episode. But to be fully engaged in the plot, I highly recommend reading all of the books in order, beginning with The Rho Agenda trilogy and the Rho Agenda Inception trilogy.

Here is yet another brilliant book from Mr. Phillips - full of vigour, action, true dilemmas and hard decisions, excellent characters, defining experiences and his famous "Oh, snap!" moments which just spice up the entire story, add entire new dimensions or give a whole new meaning to what has transpired...I find it a truly enjoyable read, and I heartily recommend not only this book, but also his "Rho Agenda" and "Rho Agenda Inception" series (I have read the entire Rho Agenda at least three times, and this is very uncommon for me these days, as my time is always at a premium). For those who have already read the series, all I can say is that "The Kasari Nexus" is just the perfect sequel to an excellent series, and that you are going to enjoy every minute of it :-D.

Here we go again! Wow what a story line. If you have to group them I'd say The Kasari Nexus takes up at the end of the first three, The Rho Agenda (The Second Ship, Immune & Wormhole) and that the second three tell the store of Jack "The Ripper" Gregory and how he got to the point we find him and his partner Janet. (The Rho Agenda Inception: Once Dead, Dead Wrong & Dead Shift) at the beginning of the first three stories. If you, like me, read those as they came out, you may have forgotten some or many points of interest! Worry not as Phillips sneaks in tid bits that jog your memory. And if you have not read the first 6 stories then those tid bits may be enough to answer your questions, "What the heck is going on?" The story, as in the first 6 takes turn after turn.
