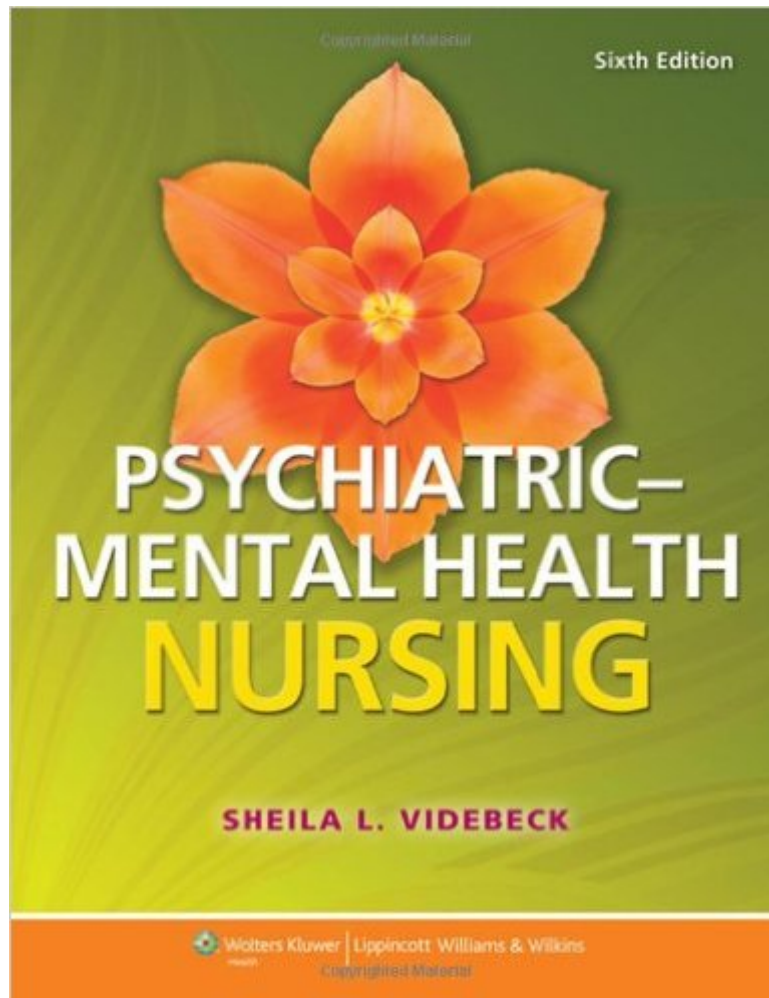

Some things are well explained, but in other areas this book falls short. There is no significant mention of stigma, which is still a major issue in Mental Health treatment. There is also incorrect information in the review of the history of psychological theories (ex: incorrect explanation of Operant Conditioning without actually naming it). It reads as if someone wrote what they remember hearing about when talking about Psychology, but not one who actually read up on and studied it. Much like when discussing mental illness, one should come at it prepared, and not relying on preexisting schema. Although it is required reading for class, I hope my school changes texts for future students.

I did a bunch of these questions prior to taking my exam. It definitely helped me get practice and allowed me to score much higher than I expected.
