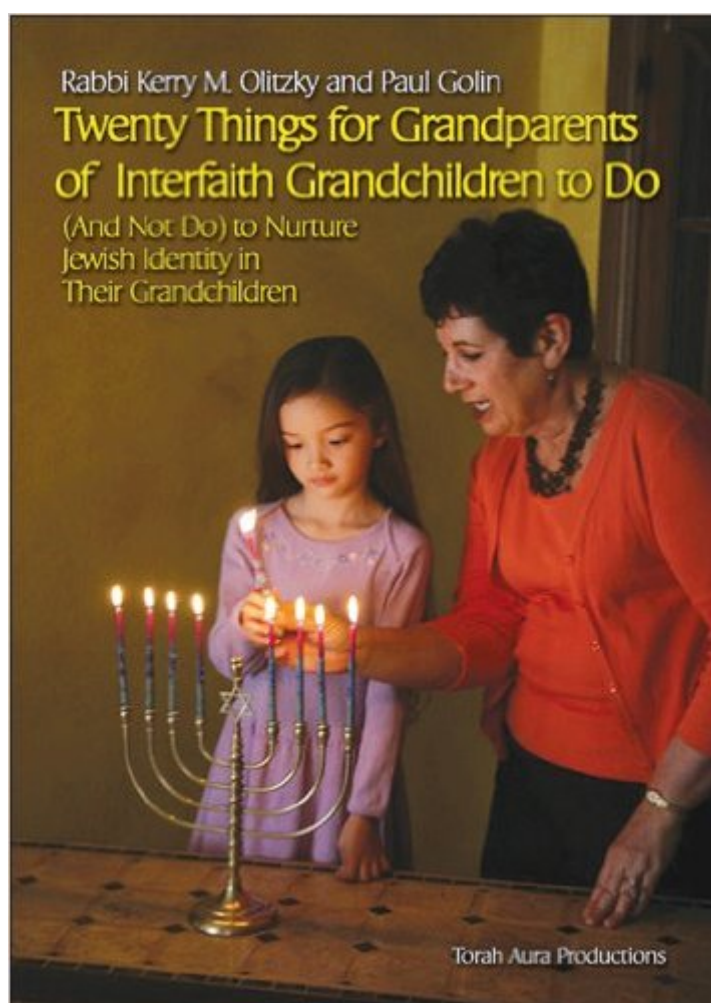

suggestion of my synagogue director. We live in a small Jewish community and both my children married non Jewish partners. Although my oldest sons wife agreed to raise my grandchildren Jewish, neither one of them has followed through aside from Hannukah presents for the grand kids. When the opportunity for a monthly Jewish introduction class for preschool children came up, they both said they didn't have the time to take my 3 year old grandson. After reading the book, I got the courage and some ideas about being as assertive as possible when it comes to giving my grandchildren as much exposure to Judaism as possible, as kindly as possible. At this point, my grandson is singing "Apples and Honey for Rosh Hashanna" and feels comfortable enough to run in the synagogue hallways. I like and recommend the book!
