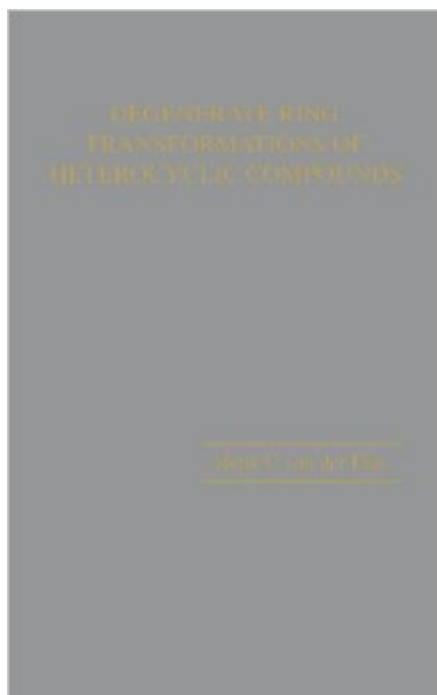


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Advances In Heterocyclic Chemistry, Volume 74



Synopsis

Established in 1960, *Advances in Heterocyclic Chemistry* is the definitive serial in the area--one of great importance to organic chemists, polymer chemists, and many biological scientists. Degenerate ring transformations of heterocycles are classified as reactions in which a heterocyclic system is converted into the same heterocyclic system. This monograph covers an authoritative, comprehensive overview of a host of degenerate ring transformations in five- and six-membered heterocycles. It shows how by the use of ^{15}N -labeled, ^{13}C -labeled, or selectively substituted compounds these degenerate ring transformations can be discovered and how most of the results can be explained by the Addition Nucleophile, Ring Opening, and Ring Closure [ANRORC] mechanism. Another main topic of the monograph is the occurrence of degenerate ring transformations.

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
