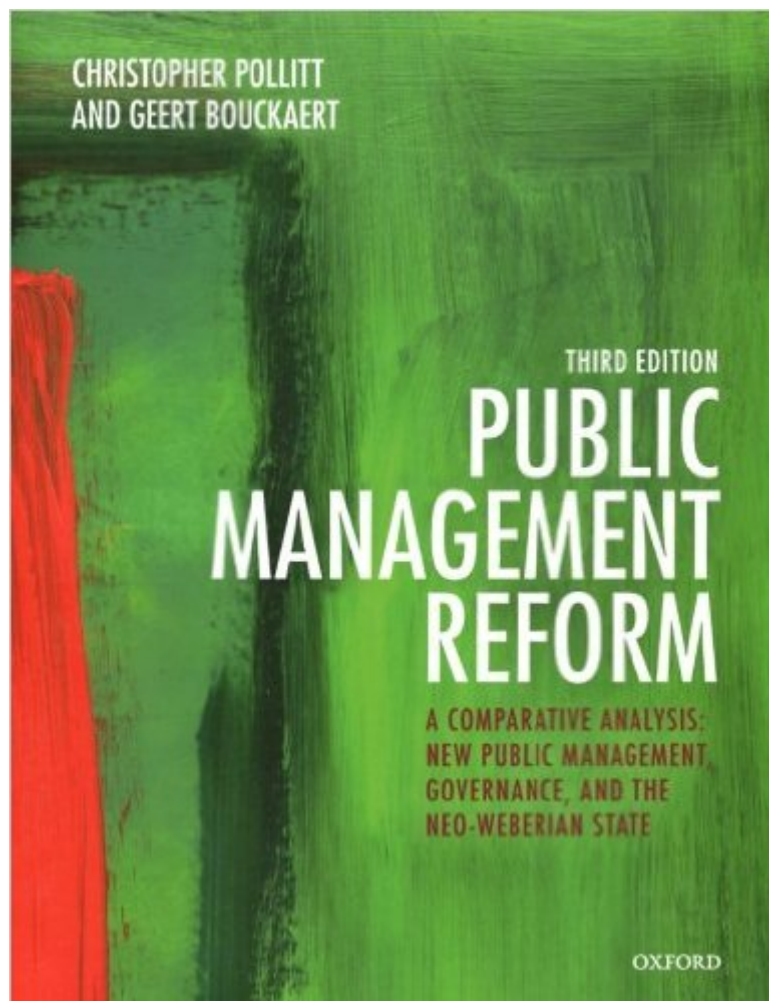


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Public Management Reform: A Comparative Analysis - New Public Management, Governance, And The Neo-Weberian State
