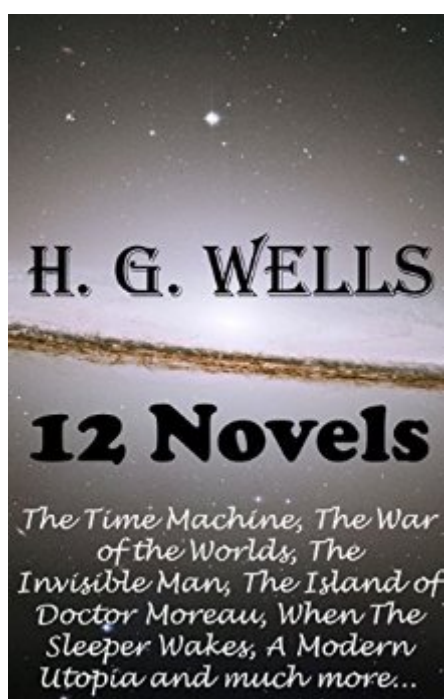

It's somewhat difficult to review a single volume which contains several separate works by an author. However, in this case, it is a little bit easier because the works and the author are well known. H. G. Wells is, along with Jules Verne, a cornerstone of modern science fiction. His works

tend to be a bit on the dark side of the speculative, but he rarely leaves his readers without hope. The 12 novels included in this Kindle edition include some of his best known works such as; "The War of The Worlds", "The Time Machine" and "The Invisible Man". I've read all of these and feel they are "must reads" for science fiction fans and I'm looking forward to reading them again (well, I've already finished "The Time Machine".) I've previously read a couple of other titles; "The Food of the Gods and how it Came to Earth", "The First Men in the Moon" and "The Island of Dr. Moreau" and am anxious to read them again. While most of the other titles will be new to me, I'm just as anxious to read them. This Kindle volume seems to be very well edited and put together so far. I have not noticed any glaring typographical errors and the original language is intact. And let's face it, \$0.99 for 12 complete novels is an awesome deal, even by Kindle standards. If you're a Sci Fi fan, the 6 titles I mentioned above are almost required reading as there is so much later Science Fiction which stems from them. The other titles (several of which I am, sadly, not yet familiar with) should further expand my connection to this amazing writer.

I've seen the movies made from many of these stories my whole life and what really struck me was how different the books are from the movies. For example The War of the Worlds was localized to England and not as international as in the films. In The Time Machine films the narrator was HG Wells yet in the book the narrator is only referred to as "The Time Traveler". I want to stress that even though there were numerous differences between the films and the books the writing is so good I enjoyed reading these books very much. I'd never read HG Wells before and reading these wonderfully written stories makes me wonder why.

When I stumbled upon this collection of H.G. Wells' works, I was pleased by the breadth of stories and the opportunity to have these classics all in one Kindle bundle. Navigation is relatively easy. The content is interactive, so looking up archaic words is easy to do. I'm not so sure Wells would make it in today's sci fi world, but recognizing him as one of the founding fathers of it makes up for the literary awkwardness and scientific backwardness. Fun stuff.

A must for the bookshelf! Too often we forget how truly grand the classics can be. These novels aren't simply "dated science fiction", they're real literature with timeless themes, engaging plots and human characters. Everyone who enjoys reading will enjoy H.G. Wells.

These are just as thrilling now as when originally written. The classics don't age.

Only Wells could have written such verse. His language at times is terse. But the imagination and pen are very Wells's. His voice rings as clearly as Sunday's bells. I recommend this volume be in your purse.

This science fiction was written in late 19th and early 20th centuries. When the Sleeper Awakes is particularly interesting with the protagonist sleeping his way into becoming the richest man in the world. I haven't yet finished A Modern Utopia. I find it a slow read.

How can you go wrong with a HUGE collection of books for only a buck?! H.G. Wells novels are exciting and fun to read. This collection will keep you busy for a very long time.

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
