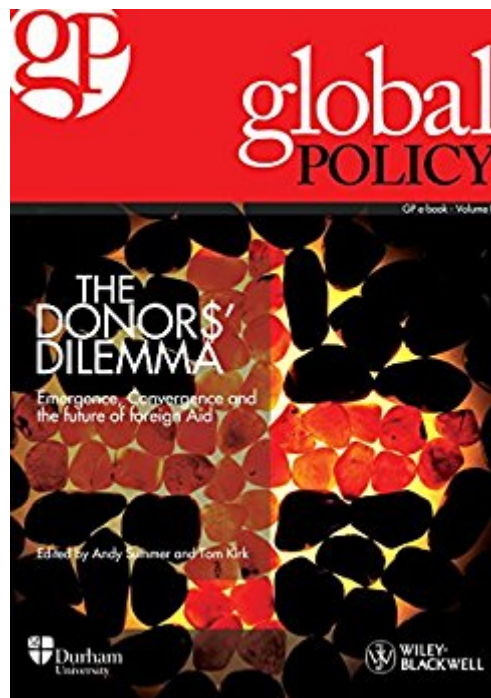


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The Donors' Dilemma: Emergence, Convergence And The Future Of Foreign Aid (Global Policy E-Books Book 1)
