

The story in general is sad and relatively interesting. But the author makes herself seem like a nosy and meddling person, who finds fault in all her neighbors and everything they do. For instance, making it a point that her neighbors car didn't have a rear view mirror, or the fact that the neighbor in the basement apartment didn't have much furniture. THat's completely irrelevant to the purpose of the story. And it makes her come off as a rather nosy and annoying neighbor. It's no wonder why the apartment manager and owner of the complex eventually got frustrated with all of her complaints.
